Cancellation Policy

Refunds on event bookings will be made as follows:

1 Cancelling Lectures, Walks or Day Trip Bookings:

No refunds will be given to members or non-members for events costing £20 or less for members.

For an event costing more than this, and where cancellations are made more than 28 days before an event, the event fee will be returned, subject to a deduction of £12 per ticket to cover administrative costs.

If a lecture, walk or day trip has to be postponed by C20, you will be offered a place on the rescheduled date. C20 will refund you should you be unable to attend on the rescheduled date, or if C20 cancels the event.

2 Cancelling UK or International Overnight Trips:

If an overnight trip has to be postponed, you will be offered a place on the rescheduled date. C20 will refund you should you be unable to attend on the rescheduled date, or if C20 cancels the event.

If you wish to cancel, C20 will refund you fully, less administrative costs of £50, if:

- you cancel more than 90 days before the event, whether or not the event is sold out; or
- if you cancel later, the event is sold out and someone takes your place 21 days before the event.

For events which are not sold out the following will apply:

- Cancellation between 28 days and 89 days before an event: 50% refund less administrative costs of £50.
- Cancellation less than 28 days before an event: no refund.

Participation in any C20 Society event will be at the participant's own risk. By participating, you acknowledge that neither C20 Society nor the leader or organiser of the event has any responsibility or liability for loss or damage to your belongings. You also acknowledge that neither C20 Society nor the leader or organiser of the event will be liable for death or personal injury unless the C20 Society is found to have failed in its duty of care to the participant.
